ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Paid and unpaid work experience that has academic and occupational education as a component of the work experience, which may include the following types of work experience:

- Summer and school year employment opportunities
- Pre -apprenticeship programs
- Internships and job shadowing
- On-the-job training opportunities.
